Swedish Toast.—This forms an excellent substitute for fried cakes in summer. Warm one pint of milk, add one cupful of sugar, one tablespoonful of lard, one-half teaspoonful of salt, one yeast cake or one-half of a cake of compressed yeast dissolved in a little warm water, two well beaten eggs, and flour enough to make a rather thin batter. If set at night add one-third teaspoonful of soda. When risen, knead into a loaf, adding flour as for bread. Rise again. Knead and roll into sheets. Sugar the tops if desired. Let them rise and bake. When cold cut into strips about three-fourths of an inch thick and toast in a very slow oven. If toasted to a light brown and thoroughly dried it will keep a long time, but soaks very quickly when dipped into coffee. Use half the sugar if too sweet. The recipe can be doubled and only two or three eggs used.

A correspondent of the New York Tribune writes: "My experience with the healthy calf is that he is about as bright an animal as the farmer has anything to do with. When he is about a day old, if I intend to raise him, I take him from the cow. He then has no settled habits to overcome, and the cow will not mourn for him as she might otherwise do. When the calf gets really hungry I take about two quarts of milk in a pail. Backing the calf into a corner, I straddle his neck, and put his head gently but firmly down until it reaches the milk. At first I give him one or two fingers to induce him to keep his head in the pail. When he has begun to take the milk I carefully draw my fingers out of his mouth, leaving his lips just below the surface of the milk, for a time holding my hand on the tip of his nose. Of course this process must be repeated many times before the calf has learned the art of eating from the pail. Some calves are wonderfully quick about learning; others learn more slowly. One must be careful not to keep the calf's head under so far that he cannot breathe. It will learn before you can tell him.

An excellent ration for the horse may be formed from one peck of ground oats, one peck bran, and one peck corn meal, with two quarts of linseed meal, the whole to be thoroughly mixed. This same ration will be found fine for suck cows, only it would be well to use rather three or four quarts of it instead of two. The ration recommended for the horse will suit the poultry first rate, only add boiled turnips or potatoes to equal the quantity of mixed grain feed used, and combine the whole into a good warm mash. Oats, corn meal and linseed meal, at present prices, are the most economical stock foods obtainable.

Going over the tree carelessly and touching a spot here and there will do no good. Great care must be taken in the preparation of the solution. Many trees and plants are killed for lack of proper attention in this respect. Spraying will pay if intelligently done.
