Details the ships, crews, cargo and conditions of 19th century Derry. Presents a historical picture of Derry trade in the 19th century and of the great wave of Irish emigrants that followed the famine years of the 1840's. Appendices have lists of vessels, crewlists, and a list of masters.

The history of the brewery from the time of purchase by Arthur Guinness in 1759, to 1876 when Edward Guinness took sole control. A survey of conditions in which the firm originated and the influence of political and economic change on its rise to a leading position in England and a dominant one in Ireland. Describes in detail a market's role in economic development.
